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INTRODUCTION

OVERVIEW OF SHENA

- A statutory body set up under the Safety, Health and Environment National Authority Order, 2018 and enforced April 2017.
- The Authority regulates and enforces all matters relating to workplace safety, health and environment as well as radiation within Brunei.
- A Chief Executive Officer (CEO) heads the Authority and is ultimately accountable for the function and affairs undertaken by the Authority. He is responsible to the SHENA Board of Directors, who report directly to the Minister in Charge (Minister of Energy).
- Appointed Inspectors and Authorised Officers have specific legal powers to enforce and regulate workplace safety, health and environment as well as radiation laws on behalf of SHENA.
- SHENA's Vision: We are committed to making a difference and ensuring Brunei is a safe place to work and live.

HSE PERFORMANCE REPORTING SYSTEM

A simple, online reporting of system, found in a tab under the Business Reporting Portal, provided by the Industry Business Ecosystem Division of MOFE.

Companies will directly or indirectly gain a number of benefits by actively compiling and publishing their own HSE performance data, including:

A system within the company that promotes a discussion and action as a follow up to an observation of an unsafe act, condition, or situation, in order to stop or prevent an unwanted event that could potentially cause harm to person or environment from happening. The intervention is also captured and recorded in written form.

DEFINITIONS

1. EXPOSURE HOURS

The number of hours worked by the employees or persons contracted to work for the company, within a specific time frame, e.g monthly.

2. MAJOR INJURIES

Injuries sustained by the employee(s) or person(s) contracted to work for the company, that require admission to hospital for at least 24 hours or granted >3 consecutive days sick leave.

3. MINOR INJURIES

Injuries sustained by the employee(s) or person(s) contracted to work for the company, that involve only first aid or medical treatment case(s) without hospitalization or being granted <3 days sick leave.

4.DANGEROUS OCCURRENCES

Any occurrences that occur at a workplace as specified in the Second Schedule of Workplace Safety and Health Order (WSHO), 2009, involving:

- bursting of revolving wheel moved by mechanical power
- collapse of crane, derrick, winch, hoist, pilling frame
- explosion or fire damage to structure of any room, machine, plant
- failure or electrical machinery, plant or apparatus involving explosion or fire
- explosion or fire affecting any room or place of work
- explosion or failure of structure of steam boiler or pressured container
- failure or collapse of formwork
- collapse of scaffolding exceeding 15 metres high
- seepage of seawater into a dry dock or floating dock





5. OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES

Any disease suffered by an employee or person(s) contracted to work for the company, at a workplace as specified in the Third Schedule of Workplace Safety and Health Order (WSHO), 2009, involving:

- Aniline poisoining
- Anthrax
- Arsenical poisoning
- Asbestosis
- Barotrauma
- Beryllium poisoning
- Byssinosis
- Cadmium poisoning
- Carbon bisulphide poisoning
- Carbon dioxide poisoning
- Carbon monoxide poisoning
- Cataract
- Chrome ulceration
- Chronic benzene poisoning
- Compressed air illness
- Cyanide poisoning
- Epitheliomatous ulceration
- Glanders
- Hydrogen sulphide poisoning
- Lead poisoning

- Leptospirosis
- Liver angiosarcoma
- Manganese poisoning
- Mercurial poisoning
- Mesothelioma
- Nitrous fumes poisoning
- Noise-induced deafness
- Occupational skin diseases
- Occupational asthma
- Pesticide poisoning
- Phosphorous poisoning
- Poisoning from halogen derivatives of hydrocarbon compounds
- Radiation
- Rengas wood poisoning
- Repetitive strain disorders
- Silicosis
- Toxic anaemia

6. SERIOUS ACCIDENT

An accident involving three or more fatalities inside or outside the premises or five or more injuries inside or outside, or release of toxic chemical or explosion or fire or spillage of hazardous substance or uncontrolled loss of containment, resulting in 'on-site' or 'off-site' emergencies or damage to asset or equipment leading to stoppage of process or adverse effects to the environment resulting in financial loss of 1 Million BND or more.



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
